

Assessing the Munich Convergence Summit Framework for Opposition Coordination and Strategic Development

The Munich Convergence Summit, convened under the leadership of Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi, represents a significant effort to unify Iranian opposition groups in response to the Islamic regime's growing internal repression and regional aggression. This report evaluates the effectiveness of the summit's framework using a SWOT analysis, identifying key strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. While the summit benefits from high-level legitimacy, diverse organizational representation, and emerging expert networks, challenges such as the lack of a clearly defined coordination mechanism, internal divisions, and regime infiltration risks persist. The report provides multiple strategic recommendations.
